

PACKING FOR CAMP

Suggested Packing List

Plan for hot and cool weather, and pack old, comfortable clothes! Also plan for activities such as pottery, gardening, sports, swimming, off-camp trips, performances, and the camp dance. There is approximately 10" of space under each bunk to store luggage, so soft duffel bags are better than trunks. This list is a guideline, and you may want to bring more or less of any item.

- 🍏 2-4 pairs jeans/pants
- 🍏 6-8 pairs shorts
- 🍏 8-10 t-shirts/tank tops
- 🍏 10 changes of underwear, 10 pairs of socks
- 🍏 1-2 pairs of sneakers or closed-toe shoes
- 🍏 1-2 pairs of flip-flops or sandals
- 🍏 1 poncho or raincoat
- 🍏 2 bathing suits, 1 robe or cover-up for after swim
- 🍏 2-3 sweatshirts/sweaters/jackets
- 🍏 2-3 pairs of pajamas
- 🍏 1 dressy outfit (for performances, dances, etc.)
- 🍏 1 shirt hanger to hang towel
- 🍏 1 water bottle
- 🍏 1 pillow, 2 pairs of sheets, 2 pillow cases, 2 blankets, 3 towels (camp will provide for free if you're traveling by plane)
- 🍏 1 drawstring laundry bag labeled with your camper's name
- 🍏 1 bag or organizer to hang on your bunk to keep all your junk neat
- 🍏 Backpack, tote bag, or small secure bag for spending money on off-camp trips
- 🍏 Brush, comb, shampoo, soap, toothbrush/paste, tissues, sunscreen, insect repellent and calamine lotion for bug bites!
- 🍏 Sunglasses, hat or visor, watch
- 🍏 Hair ties (for anyone with long hair)
- 🍏 Books, puzzles, magazines, indoor games, pen, stationery, notebook, pre-addressed and pre-stamped envelopes
- 🍏 Flashlight, battery-operated personal fan, battery-operated alarm clock, disposable camera, batteries
- 🍏 T-shirts and other clothing that can be tie-dyed, batiked, screen printed, etc.
- 🍏 Campers living in Coop (ages 12-13 or rising 7th & 8th graders) will also want to consider bring a sleeping bag for overnight camping! We have some bags available for campers to borrow if they are flying or do not own one.



Please put your camper's name on all clothing and personal belongings!

You can easily use permanent marker, or order iron-on transfers or labels. Check out the "Current Parent Area" for a list of companies who offer these products.

Additional Packing List for Special Programs, Etc...

- 🍏 **Music:** Please bring any instrument you plan to study during your majors or minors, excluding keyboards and drum sets. If you cannot bring an instrument, we have many in stock or are happy to help you rent one. Please call the Camp Directors by May 31st for information on instrument rental and pricing. Campers may also want to bring amplifiers, pick ups, sheet music, drum sticks, picks, etc. Earplugs are suggested for campers in the rock program, and will be available in the Canteen.
- 🍏 **Dance:** Leotards, tights, and dance shoes (if you have them), and an additional small mesh laundry bag
- 🍏 **Photography:** 35mm SLR film camera, with MANUAL settings. Please test your camera and make all necessary repairs before camp, and be sure to pack an extra battery. We also provide cameras for students to borrow, if needed.
- 🍏 **Technical Theatre:** Dark/black clothes for backstage, paint clothes, closed-toe shoes for working in the scene shop.
- 🍏 **Tennis:** Tennis shoes, tennis racquet, hat, sunblock. We also provide racquets for students to borrow, if needed.
- 🍏 **Horseback Riding:** Long pants, pair of boots with a heel, riding helmet (a helmet will be provided if you do not have one.)
- 🍏 **Food Allergies:** Campers with gluten allergies can bring special snacks and/or dessert items to be kept in the kitchen. Please label them with your camper's name, and give them to the Chef on Check-In Day.
